For the most part, our meetings are held at 1:30 pm at the Clarksville Town Hall in Clarksville, Indiana, at the corner of Broadway and Veteran's Parkway. If you're coming from I-65, take the Veteran's Parkway exit and turn toward the shopping areas to the west of the expressway.

Stay on Veteran's Parkway past the Wal-Mart and Sam's to the large brick complex that sits back from the parkway on the right side of the road (between Sam's and Target). The street at the far end of that complex is Broadway. Turn right, and go to the first driveway on the right. Turn toward the building (the town hall), and park on either the left or right side of the building. Enter by way of the front door, then take the staircase or elevator to the second floor. Follow the signs to the Executive Conference Room.
